Lake Flushing Starts



In an attempt to decrease the phosphorous levels in the Lake, the Silver Lake Watershed Advisory Committee (SLWAC) recommended flushing the lake. The **Silver Lake Flood Control District** has approved their recommendation to attempt to lower the lake 3', from the top of the weir, by opening the radial gate on **September 10th, 2018**. Once the lake reaches the desired level, the gate will be closed. SLWAC will continue to monitor the lake before, during and after the flushing to determine its effectiveness.
