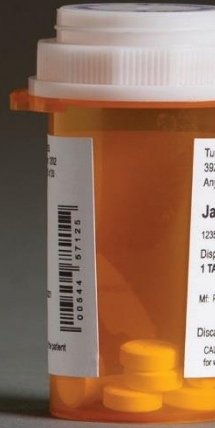




COWLITZ COUNTY OPIOID SUMMIT
