## Community Based Programs

### **COMMUNITY HOUSE ON BROADWAY**

**December 17, 2019 –December 31, 2020**

**Coordinated Entry \$53,568**

Coordinated Entry access points at Community House on Broadway Emergency Shelter, Core Health, and Core Health Social Support Center. Connect with Cowlitz County households experiencing homelessness and complete referrals to specific housing programs.

### **COWLITZ COMMUNITY NETWORK**

**July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020**

**Financial Literacy \$10,000**

Financial Literacy training for at-risk youth and families who have very low incomes, are homeless or at risk of homelessness, or are financially vulnerable. Training topics include, but are not limited to: Bank on It, Setting Financial Goals, Borrowing Basics, and Saving for Cars and College.

### **COWLITZ FAMILY HEALTH CENTER**

**December 17, 2019 –December 31, 2020**

**Coordinated Entry \$53,548**

Coordinated Entry access points at Family Health Center clinics. Connect with Cowlitz County households experiencing homelessness and complete referrals to specific housing programs.

### **EMERGENCY SUPPORT SHELTER**

**December 17, 2019 – December 31, 2020**

**Coordinated Entry \$35,000**

Coordinated Entry access point at the Emergency Support Center for those fleeing domestic violence. Connect with Cowlitz County households experiencing homelessness and complete referrals to specific housing programs.

### **EMERGENCY SUPPORT SHELTER**

**July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020**

**Shelter Operations \$95,874.50**

Emergency Shelter for victims of domestic violence as well as supportive services including: crisis intervention, safety planning, case management, goal setting for post shelter stay, legal advocacy, and support groups. Also serves as a Coordinated Entry access point for victims fleeing violence.

### **LOWER COLUMBIA CAP**

**July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020**

**Low Barrier Housing Project \$96,278**

Housing with supportive services to 6 chronically homeless, high-risk adult individuals. Supports include case management, case conferencing and coordination with other key service providers, assistance securing income benefits, increase housing stability and self-sufficiency.
