Last day to receive new registrations online or by mail: July 27, 2020

Last day to receive updates to existing registrations online or by mail: July 27, 2020

Last day to register in-person: August 4, 2020

Last day to update existing registration in-person: August 4, 2020

You may register to vote or update your voter registration at the Cowlitz County Auditor's Office, Elections Division, 207 N 4th Ave, Room 107, in Kelso between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, or online at <https://votewa.gov>.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE: The Canvassing Board of Cowlitz County, pursuant to RCW chapters 29A.60 and 42.30, will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, August 18, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., in the Cowlitz County Administration Building, 207 N 4th Ave, Kelso, in Conference Room B, to conduct the canvassing and certification of votes cast in the election.
