	<div style="text-align: center;"> PROPOSITION 2 TOUTLE LAKE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 130 CAPITAL LEVY FOR COMPUTERS AND TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT </div> <p>The Board of Directors of Toutle Lake School District No. 130 adopted Resolution No. 08-07, concerning a proposition to finance modernization of existing schools. <p>PROPOSITION NO. 1 WOODLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 404 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS-\$49,400,000</p>	<p>PROPOSITION NO. 1 COWLITZ COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 6 LEVY LID LIFT</p>
<p>The Board of Directors of Woodland School District No. 404 adopted Resolution No. 2512, concerning a proposition to finance and construct a new high school and make other capital improvements. This proposition would authorize the District to relieve overcrowding by constructing a new high school, upgrade the existing stadium to increase seating and parking, make improvements to current schools, upgrade technology for students, and address other necessary capital improvements, by issuing no more than \$49,400,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years and levying annual excess property taxes to pay and retire such bonds, all as provided in District Resolution No. 2512. Should this proposition be:</p> <p style="margin-left: 20px;"> <input type="radio"/> APPROVED <input type="radio"/> REJECTED </p>	<p>The Board of Commissioners of Cowlitz County Fire Protection District No. 6 adopted Resolution No. 2007-12-10-2 concerning an increase in the District's regular property tax levy. This proposition would allow the district to increase its regular property tax levy to provide revenues necessary to meet the maintenance and operation expenses of the District, so that in 2008 it can levy for collection in 2009 regular property taxes at the rate of \$0.96 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation, and increase the levy each year thereafter as allowed by chapter 84.55 RCW, subject to otherwise applicable statutory limits.
