MARKING YOUR BALLOT	PROPOSITION															
<p> SELECT, VOTE, AND RETURN ONE BALLOT. Two ballots have been provided: a Democratic Party (D) ballot and a Republican Party (R) ballot. Only voters residing in the Castle Rock School District will receive a third Nonpartisan (NP) ballot. You may vote only one ballot. </p> <p> THIS IS THE NONPARTISAN BALLOT. This ballot also contains a local measure for the Special Election (only for voters residing in the Castle Rock School District). </p> <p> Castle Rock School District voters who choose not to vote in the Presidential Primary may vote the Nonpartisan Special Election ballot. </p> <p> VOTE AND RETURN ONE BALLOT ONLY. Destroy and discard the remaining ballot(s). </p> <p> HOW TO MARK YOUR BALLOT To vote, completely fill in the oval of your desired candidate or response. - Use pencil or black pen. More than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted. </p> <p> HOW TO CORRECT YOUR BALLOT - Do not erase. - If you make a mistake, mark an "X" through the incorrectly filled in oval and fill in the oval of the correct candidate or response. - Signatures, comments, or identifying marks on the ballot may invalidate your ballot. - If needed, you may request a replacement ballot by contacting the Cowlitz County Auditor's Office at (360) 577-3005. </p> <p> Follow the instructions on your envelopes and instruction sheet. </p> <p> Remember to sign and date the voter's affidavit on the mailing envelope. </p>	<p style="text-align: center;"> PROPOSITION NO. 1 CASTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT 401 <u>REPLACEMENT MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY</u> </p> <p> The Board of Directors of Castle Rock School District No. 401 adopted Resolution No. 2007-83, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses.
