<p align="center">MARKING YOUR BALLOT</p> <p>1. Use only pencil or black pen.</p> <p>2. To vote — completely blacken the oval to the left of your selection. An oval blackened completely, directly to the left of a response, indicates the intent of a vote for that candidate or reply. Do not make a check-mark or an "X" to vote. An "X" over a blackened oval indicates you do not wish to have that selection counted.</p> <p>3. If you change your mind after voting your ballot, request a replacement ballot. Or, you may cross over the unwanted selection with an "X". Then, completely blacken the oval to the left of your new selection. Do not erase.</p> <p>4. Two or more ovals filled in for the same race/measure will invalidate your vote for that race/measure. Cross out the marked oval you did not wish to select using an "X".</p> <p>5. To obtain a replacement ballot, if your original ballot has been destroyed or lost, contact the Cowlitz County Elections Department, prior to 8:00 p.m., Election Day at: Elections@co.cowlitz.wa.us or (360) 577-3005.</p> <p>6. Signatures or written comments on the ballot may invalidate your ballot. Mark only the ovals to the left of the selections you would like counted.</p> <p>7. Leaving an oval blank, or not voting on a race/measure, will not invalidate your ballot. All races/measures, with ovals clearly marked, will be counted.</p> <p>8. Only vote for the number allowed. Voting for more than the number of allowed selections, stated above each selection area, will be considered an over-vote and will not be counted in that race/measure.</p> <p>9. To vote for a candidate not listed in a race, write the name of the candidate and party affiliation, if applicable, on the blank line provided at the bottom of each race. Then, completely blacken the oval to the left of the write-in candidate.</p> <p>NOTICE: Attempting to vote when not entitled, attempting to vote more than once, or falsely signing this oath is a felony, punishable by maximum imprisonment of five years, a maximum fine of \$10,000, or both. NO. 1 LEVY LID LIFT</p> <p>The Board of Commissioners of Cowlitz County Fire Protection District No. 1 adopted Resolution No. 061206 concerning a proposition authorizing the district to exceed the 101% statutory levy limit.
